Criteria for OCPhA Charitable Donations

- Advances the CPhA Mission: Advancing the practice of pharmacy for the promotion of health OR
- 2. Serves the pharmacists or pharmacies in Orange County OR
- 3. Meets one of the CPhA Chapter of Excellence Award criteria OR
 - a. Community Service Activities in which OCPhA members are invited to participate
 - i. Brown Bag Med Review
 - ii. Health Fair/Health Screening Participation
 - iii. National Pharmacy Week/Month Activities
 - iv. Poison Prevention Week Activities
 - v. Career Day Participation
 - vi. Working with Health Related Organizations
 - vii. Presentations to Community Service Groups
 - b. Political Activities in which OCPhA members are invited to participate
 - i. Political events
 - ii. Breakfast with officials
- 4. Program or activity is designed to enhance the health of those residing in Orange County OR
- 5. Program or activity whose primary focus is specifically related to improving opportunities for healthier and better-educated youth OR
- 6. Supports a California Pharmacy School student program or activity that is sponsored/supported by APhA, CPhA, or NCPA. The school must have representation on our Board (liason to the OCPhA board) AND the request must meet at least one of the above 4 criteria. Maximum donation is \$500 per Pharmacy School. The request must be presented in person at an OCPhA Board meeting in advance. AND
- 7. OCPhA Board members or OCPhA members are invited to attend
- 8. Any donation to a political organization or political campaign must be made from money raised specifically for that purpose and must not be made from general funds (includes member dues)

Process for requesting a donation:

- 1. Request for donation form is completed
- 2. Request is submitted for Board Review and consideration in advance
- 3. Request for student donation should be presented in person at an OCPhA Board meeting
- 4. For special events, a copy of the event flyer is included
- 5. Board members are invited to attend (when appropriate)
